

Golfer-of-the-Year 2025 sponsored by ProGolf Ireland

The Golfer-of-the-Year Award for the 2025 season, will be determined based on accumulated points in designated competitions across the season. The eight designated competitions are as follows: -

<u>Competition</u>	<u>Format</u>
PGA Tankard	Stroke play
Captain's Prize	Stroke play
President's Prize	Stroke play
Hodson Bay Cup	Stroke play
Eado O'Flynn	Match play
Jack O'Sullivan Trophy	Stroke play
Army Cup	Match play
Gents Club Hamper	Stroke play

In the designated competitions, GOY points are awarded based on finishing position as follows:

Strokeplay Competitions: 1st Nett-20 pts, 2nd Nett-18 pts, 3rd Nett-16 pts, 4th Nett-14 pts, 5th Nett-12 pts, 6th Nett-10 pts, 7th Nett-9pts and so on down to 15th Nett-1 point.

Matchplay Competitions: Winner-20 pts, Runner-up-16 pts, Semi-Finalists-10 pts, Quarter Finalists-4 pts

Resolving Ties: If two are more players are tied on equal points at the end of the season, the winner will be the player who has the most wins, most 2^{nds}, most 3^{rds} and so on.

Please refer to Competition Eligibilities and Restrictions for information on which membership categories are eligible to compete for the Golfer-of-the-Year award.

Men's Club Competitions

Note 1: In Strokeplay competitions with an 18-hole qualifier followed by a playoff (e.g., the Captain's Prize), points are awarded based on the standings after 27-holes.

Note 2: Players who are ineligible to compete for the GOY award, are not removed when determining the competition standings (but they are not allocated GOY points).
